The Mennonite Central Committee Material Resource Project for March is flat sheets. MCC's initial response to the earthquake in Haiti consisted of food and medical supplies, tarps, and other urgent supplies coming across from the Dominican Republic, water filtration equipment, as well as several key personnel going to do an initial assessment of the situation. Flat sheets are one item still in very short supply and they are critically needed. MCC is seeking 10,000 NEW flat sheets (double, queen, or king-size sheets in light colors) . Sheets will also be used as mosquito netting and light colors are less attractive to mosquitoes. All cotton fabric and 300 count threads are preferred, as they work the best for mosquito netting purposes. Sheets and relief kits can be brought to Spring Mount Mennonite Church or dropped off at the MCC Material Resource Center's new location at 737 Hagey Center Drive, Suite C, Souderton (next to Hagey's Bus Service on Schoolhouse Road).
